Please be seated <u>15 minutes</u> before the start of play so that the directors can determine the movement and load the bridgemates. Please note that late arrivals may be excluded from play. Directors have the discretion to exclude a late pair once the movement has been determined.

**Visitors:** Members are requested to introduce their visitors to the President and to record their name and ABF number in the visitors' book.

**SYSTEMS CARDS** are compulsory for all Red Point and Championship Events and should be used at all sessions.

The Director MUST be called for all infringements during play.

#### **SUBSTITUTES**

In events of two sessions, **no** substitutes are allowed. In **Pairs** events of three or more sessions, one substitute is allowed.

In a **Team** event, the team consists of **four players.** At least **three** of the team members must play each day. No substitute may play more than twice for the same team. A player may be a substitute for more than one team.

A substitute must be of **equal** or **lower** ranking than the player for whom they are the substitute. The use of substitutes will be at the discretion of the **Director**.

**NOMINATION Forms** will be compulsory for all **Championship, Honour Board, State** and **National** events and must be in the hands of the **Masterpoint Secretary** on the day prior to the Event.

Nominations for **Club Championship** and **Honour Board** events will only be available to **Financial** Club Members. Walk in visitors will be allowed to play in the daily competition for relevant points, but will be unable to win the event

### **TABLE ETIQUETTE**

The aim of this club is to have a pleasant playing environment, well controlled and fair to all players.

- Where the directors need to move players to arrange the fields, please move promptly and without complaint. Movements may be necessary if a field appears too unbalanced. Also when the move is called during play, move as soon as requested.
- Courtesy at the bridge table means doing nothing to discomfort any other players at your table or in the room. Greet your opposition when they come to your table and make them feel welcome.
- 3. Do not criticise the play of your partner or the opposition.
- 4. DO NOT DISCUSS THE HANDS AFTER PLAY— this gives information to adjacent tables and is unfair to the field.
- 5. THE BOARD. N/S are responsible for placing the board in the correct orientation flat on the table. It should stay there until the cards are returned to their correct pockets after play of the hand. Cards should not be removed from the board other than to play a hand; this applies to any sit-out pair. This will help reduce the incidence of fouled boards.
- 6. BRIDGEMATES. N/S are responsible for entering the score and E/W must check this before pressing the accept button. If a score is incorrectly entered and not noticed it may skew the results for the whole session. Do not read out the scores for your pair or any preceding play. This information is readily overheard and disadvantages the field.

- Declarer, when calling for a card from dummy, should do so quietly, otherwise other players know what cards are in a particular hand in a specific board and this may alter the bidding and play at other tables.
- 8. Call the director for any irregularities in the bidding and play and accept the directors ruling without argument at the table. If you consider a ruling to be wrong, then notify the intention to lodge an appeal and do so promptly at the end of play. Rule interpretations can be difficult and review of the ruling by an appeal committee (usually three directors or senior players) is the proper process.
- NOISE. Noise is a considerable problem. The Director, plus the North player at each table, is responsible for controlling this.
- 10. SPEED of PLAY. Players are expected to bid and play a hand in six minutes. The clock is normally used for all sessions. At the warning alarm, players without an opening lead card tabled may be asked not to play that board. The director will award an artificial adjusted score, with each side's percentage being dependent on the reason for not having enough time to play the board. Allowance can be made for any untoward hold-ups, including for a playing director who has several calls, or a prolonged call, during the round. Players should notify the director during the round if they feel they are being disadvantaged.
